Welcome to our first newsletter for 2021.

It has been a great albeit delayed start to the school year and it is hard to believe we are now over halfway through the term. In the first few weeks of each year, we hold an information evening where parents are invited onsite to meet in their child's classroom. STUDENT UPDATE FORMS
